

RULES OF THE SHOW

1. All classes are open to residents in the Parish of Kingswood and/or members of a Kingswood Village organisation.
2. All entries must be registered with either Angela Stephens 1 Weavers Close, Lesley Beswick 29 Orchard Walk, or Marilyn Basketter Abbey View, Abbey Street **by Thursday 3rd September 2026** - Additional forms available from The Spar Shop or on-line at www.thekva.co.uk
3. Entry fee is **50p** per exhibit for Sections A, B, C and D. No entry fee is required for Sections E, F G and H. (Please note ages are before 31st Aug)
ENTRIES TO BE SUBMITTED ON ENCLOSED FORMS with fees.
4. Any entry must not have been previously shown in the KVA Show.
5. Each Section Winner will receive a Trophy/Cup. Winners for sections A, B, C & D will receive a £10.00 prize. Prizes for sections E, F, G & H: 1st: £6.00; 2nd: £4.00; 3rd: £2.00. Points awarded for each class: 1st -3 points, 2nd-2 points, 3rd-1 point. A certificate will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class. The section winner will be the competitor with the most points in that section. A competitor may submit up to two entries in any class and each will be judged on its own merits.
The best single judged entry in the show will be awarded the Case Showday Trophy, certificate and prize.
6. All Trophies must be kept in good and clean condition and returned to the Association (addresses above) **AT LEAST ONE WEEK BEFORE** the following year's Show.
7. Please bring your exhibits (cooked items covered in cling film) to be displayed at the Village Hall on Saturday 6th September between: **8.30am & 10.00am**, and must be removed between **4.00pm & 4.30pm** on the day of the show - Prize giving will be at **4.00pm**.
8. Any exhibit not conforming to this schedule will be disqualified.
9. The decisions of the judges are final.
10. The Association will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits or property.

SECTION A: PURVIS CHALLENGE CUP - FLOWERS

1. A home-grown single rose
2. A vase of home-grown single variety flowers (5 stems)
3. An arrangement "Circus" Accessories may be used (max 45cm wide/deep)
4. Flowers floating on water
5. A pot plant, of any variety (max 30cm pot diameter)
6. A buttonhole
7. An Autumn table centrepiece. No accessories (max 30cm wide/deep)

SECTION B: EDGEVEG TROPHY - FRUIT & VEGETABLES (Home grown)

8. 3 Onions
9. 4 Runner beans
10. 2 Courgettes (10-20cm)
11. A collection of fruit & vegetables (on a tray)
12. 4 tomatoes (of the same variety)
13. A vase of culinary mixed herbs
14. Home grown fruit x 4 (of the same variety)
15. A 'funny' veg or fruit (that any clown would be proud of!)
16. Home grown salad item (not tomato) – one variety e.g. lettuce, if small item e.g. radish please enter 3 or 4

SECTION C: VILLAGE ASSOCIATION CUP - FOOD AND DRINK

PLEASE COVER COOKED ITEMS IN CLING-FILM

17. A Victoria Sandwich, strawberry jam/sprinkled with caster sugar (4 egg recipe)
18. A loaf of home-made Bread

21. 4 Sausage Rolls
22. A labelled jar of jam or marmalade
